

Pronouns

A **pronoun** is a word that takes the place of a noun.
Remember, a noun is a person, place, thing or idea.

Example: Izabella loves to dance. Izabella loves to sing, too.

To make the second sentence sound better, we can replace the word Izabella with the **pronoun "she"**.

Izabella loves to dance. She loves to sing, too.

For each sentence, we've **replaced a noun (or nouns)** with the proper **pronoun**. Each **pronoun** is colored in **red** and **underlined**.

1. *Darrell and Tyler* played the game together.
They played the game together.
2. *The tire* needed to be filled.
It needed to be filled.
3. *Ms. Smith* went to the store for her class.
She went to the store for her class.
4. *Diego and I* played basketball yesterday.
We played basketball yesterday.
5. Mom asked *John and I* to wash our hands.
Mom asked us to wash our hands.
