

## Pronouns

A pronoun is a word that takes the place of a noun. Remember, a noun is a person, place, thing or idea.

Example: Izabella loves to dance. Izabella loves to sing, too.

To make the second sentence sound better, we can replace the word Izabella with the pronoun "she".

Izabella loves to dance. She loves to sing, too.

For each sentence, we've <u>replaced</u> a noun (or nouns) with the proper <u>pronoun</u>. Each <u>pronoun</u> is colored in <u>red</u> and underlined.

- Darrell and Tyler played the game together.
   They played the game together.
- The tire needed to be filled.It needed to be filled.
- Ms. Smith went to the store for her class.
   She went to the store for her class.
- Diego and I played basketball yesterday.
   We played basketball yesterday.
- Mom asked John and I to wash our hands.
  Mom asked us to wash our hands.
