



Description of Action Verbs

Remember a **noun** is a **person**, **place** or **thing**.

Verbs are words that describe an **action** or occurrence. Verbs are very important because we can't make a sentence without them.

They tell us what is happening, and we need them.

Maddy **bakes** her cookies in the oven.

Jordan **went** to the store.

Cadence **jumped** over the puddle.

Diego's little dog **shakes** the bone.

Isabelle **searches** for her lost glove.

Remember, verbs are words that tell us what something is doing, or what happened. Action verbs are words that **SHOW** what the subject of the sentence is doing. They show movement or action.

Some examples of action verbs:

jump

dance

dig

bounce

scream

play
