



## Using Action Verbs

Remember, action verbs are words that **SHOW** what the subject of the sentence is doing. Some words are not very good at describing action.

Examples:

John did his homework.

Mary went across the field.

Diego has a new dog.

We can replace weak verbs with descriptive action verbs.  
Let's re-write these sentences with *action verbs*.

John did his homework.

John completed his homework.

Mary went across the field.

Mary scampered across the field.

Diego has a new dog.

Diego loves his new dog.

The cat has milk.

The cat slurps her milk.
