Adverbs are words or phrases that modify a verb, adverb or adjective. Adverbs express a relation of place, time, manner or degree.

The following are some examples of adverbs:

-ly adverbs	Where adverbs	When adverbs	Extent adverbs
quickly	here	now	very
slowly	there	first	100
truthfully	everywhere	last	almost
beautifully	somewhere	early	also
abruptly	in	yesterday	only
endlessly	inside	tomorrow	enough
lightly	outside	later	50
slowly	out	regularly	quite
delicately	underground	often	almost
sloppily	upstairs	never	rather
randomly	downstairs	usually	much
neatly	under	always	instead
expertly	around	soon	beyond
