



Linking Verbs

Linking verbs are words that **help** the action verb.

Linking verbs can include forms of be, can, do, has, will, shall, may and might.

In the following examples, the linking verbs are underlined and the action verbs are boxed.

1. Izabelle has **gone** to a professional football game before.
2. Vince is **taking** a long time to find his horse.
3. Mike has **seen** a dolphin in the wild.
4. We will **hike** for two miles today.
5. I am **going** to the movies tomorrow.
6. My little sister is **coming** with me.
7. Elephants are **kept** in large and natural zoo exhibits.
8. You may **watch** this video tonight.
9. Mike can **whistle** very loudly.
10. Gabriella was **bouncing** off the walls.
11. The iPhone was **broken** when it fell.
