



Parts of Speech

Adjective: An adjective describes a noun (person, place, thing).

tiny	soft	shiny	huge
beautiful	sharp	green	silent
purple	pointed	thin	magnificent

In the following sentence, the **adjectives** are colored in **yellow**.

Oh! The **little** boy ran quickly through the **high** grass to get his dad.

Verb: A verb shows an action, or describes a state of being.

jump	crawl	squat	drag
bounce	tiptoe	catch	leap
climb	bend	kick	think

In the following sentence, the **verbs** are colored in **green**.

Oh! The little boy **ran** quickly through the high grass to **get** his dad.

Adverb: An adverb describes a verb or adjective. It tells 'how', 'when', 'where' and 'how often'.

<u>HOW</u>	<u>WHEN</u>	<u>WHERE</u>	<u>HOW OFTEN</u>
loudly	soon	outside	often
sadly	today	near	once
slowly	early	away	every day
happily	before	there	frequently

In the following sentence, the **adverbs** are colored in **dark green**.

Oh! The little boy ran **quickly** through the high grass to get his dad.
