

## Parts of Speech

Adjective: An adjective describes a noun (person, place, thing).

tiny soft shiny huge beautiful sharp green silent purple pointed thin magnificent

In the following sentence, the adjectives are colored in yellow.

Oh! The little boy ran quickly through the high grass to get his dad.

Verb: A verb shows an action, or describes a state of being.

jump crawl squat drag bounce tiptoe catch leap climb bend kick think

In the following sentence, the verbs are colored in green.

Oh! The little boy ran quickly through the high grass to get his dad.

Adverb: An adverb describes a verb or adjective. It tells 'how', 'when', 'where' and 'how often'.

HOW	WHEN	WHERE	HOW OFTEN
loudly	soon	outside	often
sadly	today	near	once
slowly	early	away	every day
happily	before	there	frequently

In the following sentence, the adverbs are colored in dark green.
