Preposition: A preposition specifies a location or location in time.

about at by over since above behind for through toward across between in to with

In the following sentence, the prepositions are colored in light blue.

Oh! The little boy ran quickly through the high grass to get his dad.

Conjunction: A conjunction joins words, phrases or clauses together.

and yet so while that also if when as because then or then until unless

In the following sentence, the conjunctions are colored in dark blue.

Oh! The little boy ran quickly through the high grass until he reached his dad.

Interjection: An interjection expresses emotion. It is often followed by an exclamation point.

hey oh so sorry hello wow yeah look stop ha whew ah help gosh bye

In the following sentence, the conjunctions are colored in purple.

Oh! The little boy ran quickly through the high grass until he reached his dad.
