



## Plural Nouns

Nouns are words that name **people**, **places** and **things**.

**Plural nouns** name more than one person, place or thing.

Regular plural nouns are made plural by adding "-s" or "-es" to the end of the noun. Examples of **regular plural nouns**:

girls

teachers

cups

crowds

balls

cars

trees

skateboards

schools

swings

If a word ends in -s, -sh, -ch, -x, or -z, you add "-es".

foxes

porches

churches

buses

boxes

washes

couches

fuzzes

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Add "-es" when the word ends in "-s", "-sh", "-ch", "-x" or "-z".
