



Superlative Adjectives

Adjectives are words that describe nouns. Adjectives give us information about how something feels, looks, sounds, tastes or smells. Superlative adjectives describe a characteristic or trait to the highest or most degree.

For short adjectives that are less than two syllables, we add "-est" to the end of the adjective to create its superlative form. Note, for some words we need to double the last consonant, or change a "y" to an "i" before adding "-est". Some examples:

smallest

softest

saddest

happiest

coldest

hardest
