



## Superlative Adjectives

**Adjectives** are words that describe nouns. Adjectives give us information about how something feels, looks, sounds, tastes or smells. **Superlative adjectives** describe a characteristic or trait to the **highest degree**.

Some adjectives are irregular and do not follow the general rules of adding "-est". For example, the superlative of the adjective "good", is "best".

Examples of some irregular adjectives and their superlative forms are listed below.

Adjective	Comparative Form	Superlative Form
good	better	best
bad	worse	worst
little (amount)	less	least
much/many	more	most
far	farther	farthest
late (time)	later	latest
late (order)	latter	last
old (person)	elder	eldest

Example Sentences:

I have the **most** eggs collected.

I feel my best when I am healthy.
