

## Verbs

Linking verbs are words that help the action verb.

Linking verbs can include forms of be, can, do, has, will, shall, may and might. For example, the linking verb is underlined and a box is drawn around the action verb:

Caroline has painted a beautiful castle.

Mike can climb the rock wall by himself.
