

## **Prefixes**

A prefix is a group of letters placed at the beginning of a root word that changes its meaning. For example: charge becomes recharge by adding the prefix "re-".

Some examples of prefixes and their meaning:

prefix	meaning	e×ample
re	again	I need to recharge my smartphone.
un	not	Those flowers are unlike each other.
semi	half / twice per	We need to go around the semicircle. He wants to go semiweekly.
anti	against	He is antiwar in his beliefs.
pre	before	Please preheat the oven to 350 degrees.
dis	opposite	He dislikes tomatoes.
de	opposite	They deactivated my account.
in	opposite	I was indecisive in my choice.
in	toward	There were an influx of customers.
inter	between	The highway interchange was confusing.
fore	before	Forethought is needed.
mid	middle	Pick anyday midweek please.
mis	wrong	His attempt was misguided.
