

## Rhyming Words (page 1)

Words that rhyme share similar (or the same) sound, usually in the final syllable.

For example, the word ball rhymes with wall, because both share the same ending sound - "all". The word dog rhymes with fog, because both share the same ending sound - "og".

Here are some more examples of rhyming words:
