

A **sentence** is a group of words that expresses a complete thought, asks a question, or issues a command. A sentence usually contains a subject and predicate (verb).

Sentences should tell you both who (or what) did something, and what they did. Make a complete sentence by picking a subject (who or what) and a predicate (what they did).

The little girl	ate some grass.
The black cow	galloped around the corral.
The grey wolf	played with her doll.
The brown horse	clapped loudly.
The thunder	chased the rabbit.
