



Sentence Structure (page 7)

A **sentence** is a group of words that expresses a complete thought, asks a question, or issues a command. A sentence usually contains a subject (noun) and predicate (verb), and must express a complete thought.

A **compound sentence** has two complete thoughts joined by a conjunction such as *and*, *but*, *or*, *nor*.

Combine the two sentences into one compound sentence using a conjunction.

1. I want to go to the movies.

Scott wants to go to the theater.

2. Bella hiked down the trail.

Bella tripped on a rock.

3. Mike washed the dirty dog.

Isabelle cleaned the stinky dog bed.

4. I spilled my water on the table.

Jake cleaned up the spill.
