

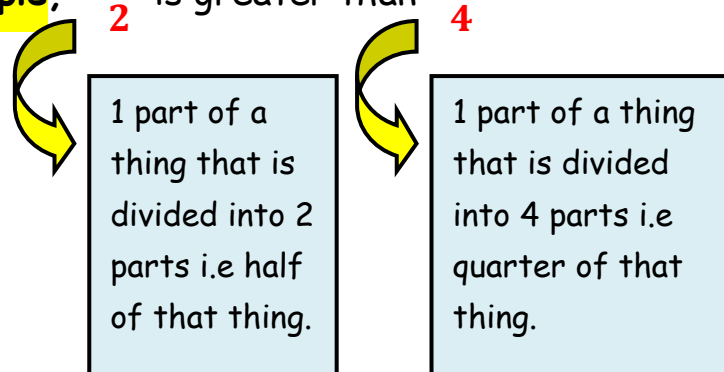
FRACTIONS

(Bigger and Smaller Fractions)

Fractions show part of a whole thing.

The fraction is **smaller** if the whole thing is divided into more parts.
The fraction show a **bigger** part if the whole thing is divided into lesser parts.

For example, $\frac{1}{2}$ is greater than $\frac{1}{4}$



1 part of a thing that is divided into 2 parts i.e half of that thing.

1 part of a thing that is divided into 4 parts i.e quarter of that thing.

If both the fractions have same denominators, the one with the bigger numerator is a bigger fraction.

If both the fractions have different denominators, the one with the smaller denominator is a bigger fraction.
