

## **FRACTIONS**

(Making Fractions on the Number Line)

**Fractions** show part of a whole thing. Fractions almost always represent numbers between  $\bf 0$  and  $\bf 1$  i.e. they are greater than  $\bf 0$  and less than  $\bf 1$ .

For example:  $\frac{3}{8} \implies 3$  equal parts of a whole thing which is divided in 8 parts.

Fractions can be shown on the number line in the following way.

First, draw a number line and mark 0 and 1 on its both the ends.



Divide the number line evenly by putting small marks on it. for example if you want to divide it into 3 parts, put 2 marks on it so that it gets divided in 3 parts.



Now mark the fractions on it like 1/3, 2/3, 3/3 = 1(which is already there).
