## FRACTIONS

(Making Fractions on the Number Line)
Fractions show part of a whole thing. Fractions almost always represent numbers between 0 and 1 i.e. they are greater than 0 and less than 1.

For example: $\frac{3}{8} \Rightarrow \begin{aligned} & 3 \text { equal parts of a whole thing which is divided in } 8 \\ & \text { parts. }\end{aligned}$

Fractions can be shown on the number line in the following way.
First, draw a number line and mark 0 and 1 on its both the ends.


Divide the number line evenly by putting small marks on it. for example if you want to divide it into 3 parts, put 2 marks on it so that it gets divided in 3 parts.


Now mark the fractions on it like $1 / 3,2 / 3,3 / 3=1$ (which is already there).
