

## FRACTIONS

(Making Fractions on the Number Line)

**Fractions** show part of a whole thing. Fractions almost always represent numbers between 0 and 1 i.e. they are greater than 0 and less than 1.

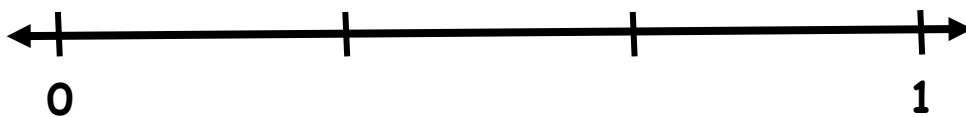
For example:  $\frac{3}{8}$   $\rightarrow$  3 equal parts of a whole thing which is divided in 8 parts.

Fractions can be shown on the number line in the following way.

**First**, draw a number line and mark 0 and 1 on its both the ends.



Divide the number line evenly by putting small marks on it. for example if you want to divide it into 3 parts, put 2 marks on it so that it gets divided in 3 parts.



Now mark the fractions on it like  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{2}{3}$ ,  $\frac{3}{3} = 1$  (which is already there).
