'Addition and Subtraction of Money'

Addition and subtraction of money is easy.

We carry out the operations on money as we do on simple numbers.

For Example:

Subtract **\$25.70** (25 dollars & 70 cents) from **\$30.95** (30 dollars & 95 cents).

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{→} \quad \$ 30.95 \\ - \$ 25.70 \\ \hline 5.25 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

Add **\$25.70** (25 dollars & 70 cents) from **\$30.95** (30 dollars & 95 cents).

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{→} \quad \$ 30.95 \\ + \$ 25.70 \\ \hline 56.65 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

Similarly if we have coins [**penny**(¢1), **dime**(¢10), **nickel**(¢5), **quarter**(¢25) or **half-dollars**(¢50)], we simple add the values of coins in cents together.
