
'Counting and Making Bills'

We count the dollars bills in the same way as we count the coins.

A five dollar (\$5) bill is equal to 5 one-dollar bills.


A ten dollar (\$10) bill is equal to 2 five-dollar bills or 10 one-dollar bills.

For Example:



 \Rightarrow If we count the above bills, they add up to make \$34.

Similarly, we can count coins along with bills too.



The above coins and bills add up to make \$12.06.
