

HANDLING DATA

'Pictorial Representation of Data' (Pictographs)

A **Pictograph** is a way to represent data. It uses pictures or specific symbols to show or represent the information you have collected.

Each picture can represent 1 or more items.

There is always a **key** in a pictograph to show how many each picture represents.

The following pictograph shows the number of children present in class on each day of the week.

Monday	
Tuesday	
Wednesday	
Thursday	
Friday	

Key: con represents 5 children

The pictograph shows that there are 30 children present on Monday, 20 children present on Tuesday, 25 present on Wednesday and so on.
