Running through the house grabbing keys, purse, and boots	Middle: Rushing around trying to get ready to leave the house after hearing the good news that the new horse had arrived	Just Amanda with mother watching but saying nothing
At the barn staring at a large black and white horse	End: Standing beside a new horse with arms wrapped around her neck as the horse looks on at the new barn	Amanda Friend who is also checking out the horse
