Definitions

froth (noun)	a form of bubbles, fizz, or foam
gulp (verb)	to swallow something, usually in a large quantity
stinging (verb)	to feel a prick, tingling, or sharp pain
stung (verb)	to have felt a prick, tingling, or sharp pain
bare (adjective)	lacking covering or embellishments; basic; showing only the basic, naked, or pure form of something
scatter (verb)	to disperse or separate things in a random manner across an area
wriggle (verb)	to quickly move by twisting or wiggling
