Let's talk about planes and answer the questions using round off the numbers.

- a) During July, at the airport was recorded an increase in the number of passengers. Namely, as many as 2 342 153 passengers. On the news, there was an approximate number. Grandma Natalie heard 2 000 000, while Grandma Dorothy heard that there were 3 000 000 passengers. Which Grandma is right?
- b) After the summer season, the number of passengers decreased, so for the next two months there were 1 535 842 passengers, which is half a million less than last year at the same time. How many passengers, approximately, were recorded last year?
- c) In March, this year, the profit of the airport was only \$ 9 489 950. Round off that sum to the nearest hundred, and then compare it with \$ 9 500 000.
- d) Based on 7 563 787 ratings of satisfied passengers during this summer, we can say that the airline has made a great success. That's about:
