We add **-er** to the adjective when comparing two things and **-est** when three or more.

- 4) Singapore is **(smaller, smallest)** than India.

- 7) Paris is **(colder, coldest)** than London.
- 8) Antarctica is the **(colder, coldest)** place on Earth.
- 9) Nora picked the **(softer, softest)** blanket from the shop.
