



## Present Perfect Tense

The present perfect tense indicates an action that extends to the present or the action that was perfected (finished or completed) at some point in the past. This type of tenses is formed by **has/have** plus the **past participle** of the verb.

Example:

They **have begun** the game of throne.

I **have caught** the thieves.

We **have eaten** immediately we came back from school.
