

Past Perfect Tense

Past Perfect Tenses expresses action or event that took place in the past and had also been concluded at some point in the past.

It expresses something you had done or completed before something else happened. It is formed by using the past form of have (HAD) along with the past participle of a verb in a sentence.

Examples:

I had visited the market earlier.

Dad had watched the football match.

She had taken her drugs before she slept off.
