<b>agriculture</b> (noun)	science associated with farming or animals	"My family is in agriculture.", "the agriculture department"
ecosystem (noun)	biological community in which plants, animals, and other organisms interact in an environment	"We are studying the ocean as an ecosystem.", "The ecosystem was damaged."
<b>adverse</b> (adjective)	harmful or dangerous	"adverse reaction", "an adverse effect"
sanitation (noun)	related to cleaning or disposal for public health	"Sanitation helps keep us healthy.", "the sanitation department"
urban (adjective)	characteristic of a city or town; inner-city; specific collective area	"urban contemporary fashion", "the urban population"
