



SUBTRACTION

'Subtraction of 5 digit numbers (with & without regrouping)'

Subtraction of 5 digit numbers is same as subtracting any 2 other numbers, like we have been doing before. Just be careful where you need to regroup!

Look at the following example to understand completely.

Example: Subtract.

$$\begin{array}{r} 41745 \\ - 12270 \\ \hline \\ \hline \end{array}$$

Solution:

$$\begin{array}{r} \overset{3}{\cancel{4}} \overset{11}{1} \overset{6}{\cancel{7}} \overset{1}{4} 5 \\ - 12270 \\ \hline \boxed{29475} \end{array}$$
