


NUMBERS UPTO 100,000

'Place Value of 5 and 6 Digit Numbers'


In a 5 digit or 6 digit numbers, each number is at a specific place and has a value according to its place, like we have already learned for smaller numbers.

Look at the following numbers.





6 Digit Number



The value of a digit in the number is the digit times its place value.

For example:

The value of 3 in the number 23,457 is $3000 = 3 \times 1000$ Similarly,

The value of 6 in the number 568,356 is $60,000 = 6 \times 10,000$
