## FRACTIONS

'Proper and Improper Fractions'

An Improper Fraction is a fraction in which the numerator is greater than or equal to the denominator.

For example: $\frac{5}{2}, \frac{16}{9}, \frac{67}{40}, \frac{132}{17}$ etc are all improper fractions.

A Proper Fraction is a fraction in which the numerator is always less than the denominator.

For example: $\frac{6}{7}, \frac{2}{15}, \frac{24}{55}, \frac{137}{175}$ etc are all proper fractions.
