

Solve the following word problems.

1) Tina needs  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup of apple juice,  $\frac{3}{4}$  cup of orange juice and  $\frac{1}{4}$  cup of pineapple juice to make a yummy cocktail. How many cups of juices does need altogether?

2) Simra had  $2\frac{1}{4}$  cups of flour. She used  $\frac{5}{8}$  cup of flour to make a cake. How much flour is now left with her?

3) Mom finished all the cooking in  $1\frac{1}{4}$  hour and did all the cleaning in  $\frac{3}{4}$  hour. In how much time mom finish all her work?

4) Emma has to read a book over the weekend. She read  $\frac{2}{5}$  part of the book on Saturday and  $\frac{1}{4}$  part on Sunday. How much book has she read? Has she finished reading it or not?

5) I ate  $\frac{4}{7}$  of the cake and my brother ate  $\frac{1}{3}$  of the cake. How much cake did we eat altogether?

4)  $\frac{13}{20}$  , no she hasn't finished yet.
