Alternative Energy Sources

Perhaps you have heard talk of the use of fossil fuels. Fossil fuels are created by decaying organic material over the course of many years. The overuse of these lead to pollution as we divest resources that cannot be replaced. The alternative is to start using things like solar power and hydropower as an energy source. In many places, these are already in use and surpass the use of natural gas and coal. This is a great option, but the transition requires time, money, and effort.

Some find government subsidies provide an impetus to make the switch and totally eliminate reliance on fossil fuels, but barring some type of incentive, this is unlikely. Eventually, the plunging availability of coal and natural gas will force some areas to make a significant change, but this is something to prepare for sooner rather than later. It is profoundly important that we learn more about these alternative energy sources before it is too late, even though this sounds like pessimism. Knowledge about the options, make the actual transition much easier when it does become necessary.
