Explaining the Abduction: Police Version

One **witness** to him standing outside the hospital had tried to **confront** him to see if he needed help, but he ran away.

The **offender** was said to be acting injured in order to **lure** his victim nearby to grab her. Everyone is asked to be **vigilant** in the area to watch for him and the police will send **patrol** cars around often. Once caught, the suspect will be **remanded** to lock-up without bail because he has already tried to run.

When a report like this is written, it is not to **tarnish** someone and **depict** them as a criminal, but to provide the facts that are available at the moment. This can run the **spectrum** from someone losing a credit card to murder and everything in between. The police are required to handle things a certain way until the truth is discovered.
