Word	Meaning	Examples
ecosystem (noun)	interacting organisms that exist in a biological community	"a marine ecosystem"; "a delicate ecosystem"
imperial (adjective)	magnificent, regal, majestic	"an imperial look"; "huge and imperial tree"
instructive (adjective)	informative, instructional, useful	"an instructive seminar"; "instructive computer class"
strangulate (noun)	hinder, strangle, or hamper	"strangulate growth"; "strangulate development"
organisms (noun)	something alive from a person, plant, or animal to a single cell being	"animals and other organisms"; "multiple organisms"

Word	Meaning	Examples
aquatic (adjective)	describing a plant or animal that live in or near water for survival	"aquatic plants"; "Fish are aquatic."
terrestrial (adjective)	living on the ground or earth (plant or animal)	"terrestrial animal"; "terrestrial being"
biotic (adjective)	related to living things and how they relate	"biotic diversity"; "biotic community"
abiotic (adjective)	sterile and without life, never alive	"The wind is abiotic"; "Abiotic factors can affect the environment."
intact (adjective)	unbroken, complete, undamaged	"intact building"; "intact bones"

Word	Meaning	Examples
radical (adjective)	thorough, total, extreme	"radical changes to the environment"; "radical overhaul"
interconnected (adjective)	linked, connected	"interconnected parts"; "interconnected ideas"
jeopardy (noun)	failure, danger of loss, peril	"in jeopardy"; "My health was in jeopardy."
resilience (noun)	ability to recover, be tough, or bounce back	"showed resilience"; "the resilience of nature"
detrimental (adjective)	often causing harm, damaging, hurtful	"detrimental to health"; "detrimental effects"
