Word	Meaning	Examples
<b>pandemic</b> (noun)	outbreak of a pandemic or widespread disease	"the influenza pandemic"; "the COVID pandemic"
<b>socioeconomic</b> (adjective)	concerned with the interacting factors of social and economic factors	"socioeconomic concerns"; "socioeconomic factor like income"
<b>pose</b> (verb)	to present, create, or give rise to an issue or problem	"pose a problem"; "that will pose an issue"
<b>fragile</b> (adjective)	easily damaged, weak, or broken	"fragile glass bowls"; "fragile newborn"
<b>lockdown</b> (noun)	a state of restriction or isolation as a matter of security	"all states on lockdown"; "a six month lockdown"

Word	Meaning	Examples
<b>wage</b> (noun)	a regular payment made by employers to employees, often for manual or unskilled worker	"minimum wage"; "a living wage"
<b>domestic</b> (adjective)	inside or existing in a particular country, state, or home	"domestic affairs in the US"; "domestic relations are low"
<b>havoc</b> (noun)	devastation, destruction, damage that is widespread	"wreaked havoc"; "causing havoc in the small town"
<b>caregiver</b> (noun)	a family member, friend, or paid helper who cares for a sick person or child regularly	"a loving caregiver"; "a dedicated caregiver"
<b>multitude</b> (noun)	a large gathering or mass amount, usually of people	"a gathering multitude"; "a multitude of cases"

Word	Meaning	Examples
<b>ancillary</b> (adjective)	providing support the primary activities of a company or industry	"an ancillary nurse"; "ancillary officer on duty"
<b>ventilator</b> (noun)	respirator, machine to help someone breathe	"on a ventilator"; "need a ventilator temporarily"
<b>frontline</b> (noun)	the most important person or people for a cause	"a frontline worker"; "frontline doctors"
<b>isolate</b> (verb)	causing someone or something to remain alone or separate from the world	"isolate the ill"; "isolate the town"
<b>repercussions</b> (noun)	an unintended result, outcome, or consequence	"unintended repercussions"; "repercussions from the decision"
