Word	Meaning	Examples
<b>quarantine</b> (noun)	a period or place of isolation after someone or something has been exposed to a contagious disease	"a two week quarantine"; "need to quarantine"
<b>implement</b> (verb)	to put a plan into effect or execute a plan	"implement a new schedule"; "implement the new protocol"
<b>efficacy</b> (noun)	able to produce an intended result; effectiveness	"efficacy of the treatment"; "efficacy of the vaccine"
<b>inbound</b> (adjective)	traveling toward a specific place, especially referring to the original point	"an inbound plane"; "inbound traffic"
<b>incidence</b> (noun)	rate or frequency of something undesirable	"increased incidence of COVID"; "declining incidence of exposure"

Word	Meaning	Examples
<b>recoup</b> (verb)	to regain or recover	"recoup our losses"; "recoup strength after the illness"
<b>tourism</b> (noun)	the commercial organization, as well as operation, of visits to places of interest	"tourism suffered"; "relying on tourism"
<b>clobbered</b> (verb)	to hit, strike, or smack	"clobbered the snake"; "clobbered the opponent in the ring"
<b>inaugurate</b> (verb)	to introduce or begin a new system or policy	"inaugurate the new policy"; "inaugurate a new way of life"
<b>subservient</b> (adjective)	submissive, obeying others without question	"a subservient attitude"; "the subservient masses"

Word	Meaning	Examples
<b>faltering</b> (adjective)	losing momentum or moving hesitantly	"faltering speech"; "faltering steps"
<b>intrusive</b> (adjective)	invasive, causing disruption due to being unwelcomed or uninvited	"the intrusive thoughts"; "intrusive tests"
<b>cautious</b> (adjective)	careful, attentive, watchful, avoiding danger	"be cautious", "a cautious approach"
<b>contracted</b> (verb)	to catch or develop, usually a disease	"contracted the virus"; "contracted a serious illness"
<b>mandatory</b> (adjective)	required, compulsory, required by law	"mandatory mask wearing"; "mandatory meetings"
