Word	Meaning	Examples
<b>smuggled</b> (verb)	to move something illegally, goods or other things	"smuggled in drugs"; "smuggled under a coat"
<b>illicit</b> (adjective)	illegal, forbidden by law or custom, unlawful	"illicit photos"; "illicit drugs"
<b>supervise</b> (verb)	oversee, watch, observe a specific task	"supervise the visit"; "supervise the interview"
<b>counterfeit</b> (adjective)	fake, copied, made to be an imitation of something valuable	"counterfeit money"; "counterfeit high-end purses"
<b>nefarious</b> (adjective)	evil, criminal, wicked intent	"nefarious activities"; "nefarious ideas"

Word	Meaning	Examples
<b>deputed</b> (verb)	designate, appoint, nominate to perform a task for someone else who is responsible	"deputed to look after him"; "deputed to be temporary manager"
<b>collude</b> (verb)	conspire, cooperate in a secret or unlawful manner to gain an advantage or deceive	"collude with the enemy"; "collude together to hide the crime"
<b>agencies</b> (noun)	business or organization that provides a specific service	"police agencies"; "social service agencies"
<b>intercepted</b> (verb)	stopped, obstructed something to prevent from continuing	"intercepted the ball"; "intercepted the call"
<b>custody</b> (noun)	guardianship or protective care of someone or something, safe keeping	"custody of the child"; "custody of the ring"

Word	Meaning	Examples
<b>extradite</b> (verb)	to deport or hand someone over to another jurisdiction due to a crime	"extradite him to Canada"; "extradite the suspect to Florida"
<b>surveil</b> (verb)	to monitor someone or something closely or watch them	"surveil the area"; "surveil the man in the hoodie"
<b>prosecute</b> (verb)	to start legal proceedings against	"prosecute the case"; "prosecute both men"
<b>treaty</b> (noun)	agreement, deal, a formal pact	"form a treaty"; "treaty over the land"
<b>department</b> (noun)	a division or section of a larger organization	"police department"; "department of defense"
