<b>Word</b>	<b>Meaning</b>	<b>Examples</b>
<b>indicted</b> (verb)	to formally accuse with a serious crime	"indicted yesterday"; "indicted by the courts"
<b>hijack</b> (verb)	to take over or seize to use for personal purposes	"hijack the plane"; "hijack the meeting"
<b>breach</b> (noun)	breaking or not observing a code of conduct, law, or agreement	"breach of trust"; "breach of contract"
<b>horrific</b> (adjective)	dreadful, frightful, causing horror	"a horrific sight"; "horrific scene"
<b>stark</b> (adjective)	bare appearance, sheer, severe	"stark appearance"; "stark contrast"

Word	Meaning	Examples
<b>commandeered</b> (verb)	seize, officially take possession of, requisition	"commandeered the tank"; "commandeered by the general"
<b>fuselage</b> (noun)	body of an airplane, the main part	"damage to the fuselage"; "200-foot fuselage"
<b>haul</b> (verb)	drag, pull, transport with force or effort	"haul the car"; "haul the evidence"
<b>offence</b> (noun)	breach of law or rule, something illegal	"neither offence is jail worthy"; "offence to justice"
<b>disguise</b> (verb)	to give a new appearance so identity is concealed or to hide the nature of as part of a cover up	"disguise yourself as a local"; "disguise the truth"

Word	Meaning	Examples
<b>negotiation</b> (noun)	a discussion that is focused on reaching an agreement	"negotiation of the contract"; "under negotiation"
<b>hostage</b> (noun)	a person held or seized as a captive or prisoner until a condition is fulfilled	"taken as a hostage"; "a hostage inside"
<b>clandestine</b> (adjective)	secret, covert, stealthy usually because it is illicit	"a clandestine affair"; "clandestine meeting"
<b>exile</b> (noun)	barred from a native country, banished	"a political exile"; "forced into exile"
<b>aviation</b> (noun)	operating or flying an aircraft of some kind	"modern aviation"; "aviation museum"
