**Directions:** Detectives had to fill out a report on the accident. Help them fill in the missing words to complete the report.

Upon arriving at the scene, three \_\_\_\_\_ (*fender, troopers, fishtailed*) were assessing the damage and taking photos of the area. It appeared that a \_\_\_\_\_ (*deliberately, reckless, hoofed*) driver had jumped the curb and hit a \_\_\_\_\_ (*hoofed, pedestrian, intersection*) at the crosswalk of the \_\_\_\_\_ (*intersection, fishtailed, fender*). Though the hit was not \_\_\_\_\_ (*unduly, fatal, deliberately*), the person hit will face a long recovery and has suffered several broken bones.

The offending vehicle was recovered at the scene and \_\_\_\_\_ (*impounded, deterrent, traumatic*). One \_\_\_\_\_ (*deterrent, fender, reckless*) was found 100 yards away and photographed and collected as evidence as well. The scene was \_\_\_\_\_ (*preliminary, intersection, traumatic*) for those in the accident and those who witnessed it. Upon interviewing witnesses, \_\_\_\_\_ (*impounded, preliminary, pedestrian*) reports are showing the driver was impaired, possibly due to drinking, and stumbled several times after getting out of the car and running away.

The license plate number was run by a \_\_\_\_\_ (*troopers, pedestrian, detective*) and found to belong to a guy that lived nearby. He has been picked up for questioning. He was \_\_\_\_\_ (*deterrent, unduly, fishtailed*) calm for someone who had just been taken into questioning and possibly been in a horrible accident. When he is officially charged, he will likely pay a hefty fine and serve time in jail once the case has been proven.
