Word	Meaning	Examples
intersection (noun)	a point when two surfaces, typically roads	"meet at the intersection"; "intersection of Main and 3 rd
	meet or intersect; junction	Street"
troopers	police, officers, US	"troopers stormed the room";
(noun)	state policer officer	"troopers responded quickly"
impounded	seized, took custody of	"impounded the car"; "impounded
(verb)	legally, confiscate	after the wreck"
preliminary	noting an event or action	"preliminary results"; "preliminary
(adjective)	that precedes or was done in preparation; initial	events"
fender	the guard around a wheel	"fender damage"; "dented fender"
(noun)	well on a vehicle

Word	Meaning	Examples
pedestrian (noun)	someone walking along a road or in an area that is developed; hiker	"pedestrian crossing"; "pedestrian on the main road"
reckless (adjective)	thoughtless, careless, without thinking	"reckless behavior"; "reckless driving"
fatal (adjective)	deadly, lethal, leading to disaster	"fatal accident"; "wreck was fatal"
deterrent (noun)	something that discourages and action or response	"deterrent to crime"; "criminal deterrent"
unduly (adverb)	excessively, unwarranted amount or degree	"unduly alarmed"; "unduly upset"
