Word	Meaning	Examples
cybercrime (noun)	a crime or criminal activity that is carried out	"cybercrime division"; "convicted of cybercrime"
susceptible (adjective)	likely to be harmed by a specific thing or easily influenced	"susceptible to fraud"; "susceptible to lies"
laissez-faire (noun)	an attitude of letting things take whatever course without interfering in any way	"laissez-faire attitude"; "laissez- faire approach to life"
cohort (noun)	a specific group of people that are seen as a group	"cohort of women"; "cohort of teenagers"
bot (noun)	an autonomous online program that can interact with a system or users	"chat bot"; "program a bot"

cynical (adjective)	skeptical, doubtful, believing others are only motivated by self- interest	"cynical outlook"; "cynical attitude"
realm	an area or domain of	"online realm"; "realm of cyber
(noun)	interest	criminals"
espionage	using spies or the	"government espionage"; "secrecy
(noun)	practice of spying most often associated with government	of espionage"
attribution	regarding something as	"problems of attribution";
(noun)	being caused by a specific person or thing	"attribution to a terrorist group"
malware	software that has been	"malware scan"; "malware stole
(noun)	designed to damage or gain unauthorized access to some system	data"
