Word	Meaning	Examples
<b>forgery</b> (noun)	counterfeiting, creating a copy without permission, falsifying	"arrested for forgery"; "guilty of forgery"
<b>white-collar</b> (adjective)	descriptive of nonviolent crimes committed by those who work in an office or professional setting	"white-collar criminal"; "white-collar crime of money laundering"
<b>absconding</b> (verb)	running away, escaping, fleeing	"absconding from the law"; "absconding with the money"
<b>purportedly</b> (adverb)	appearing true, allegedly true, but not necessarily	"purportedly show innocence"; "purportedly at his mother's house"
<b>donning</b> (verb)	to put on, usually clothing	"donning my best dress"; "donning a jersey for the game"

Word	Meaning	Examples
<b>incriminating</b> (adjective)	making someone look guilty of wrongdoing or a crime	"incriminating evidence"; "the incriminating photo"
<b>procure</b> (verb)	to obtain with effort, find, acquire	"procure a conviction"; "procure supplies for the trip"
<b>implicated</b> (verb)	shown to be involved with or in a crime, incriminate	"implicated in the plan"; "implicated in the bombing"
<b>interim</b> (adjective)	temporary, short-term, for a time	"interim judge"; "interim professor"
<b>pandering</b> (verb)	to indulge some distasteful need or habit, fulfill, cater to	"pandering to the crowd"; "pandering to the lowest class"

Word	Meaning	Examples
<b>restriction</b> (noun)	a limiting measure, often a legal one	"restriction on movement"; "placed on restriction"
<b>evade</b> (verb)	elude, avoid, escape by trickery	"evade arrest"; "evade capture"
<b>discretion</b> (noun)	behaving in a way to avoid offering sensitive information, caution	"use discretion"; "I trust you to rely on my discretion."
<b>regulatory</b> (adjective)	intended to regulate	"regulatory practices"; "regulatory framework"
<b>signatories</b> (noun)	a party or person that has signed an agreement that is binding	"documents require two signatories"; "signatories included the officers and lawyer"
