Word	Meaning	Examples
aggregate (adjective)	formed by combining separate units; total; combined	"gathered snacks to aggregate as a meal"; "got an aggregate of nutritional foods"
ample (adjective)	plentiful; sufficient; abundant	"ample options"; "ample supply of product"
belligerent (adjective)	hostile; threatening; aggressive	"a belligerent customer"; "a belligerent exchange"
callous (adjective)	heartless; cold; unhearing	"a callous attitude"; "a callous person"
delectable (adjective)	delicious; appetizing; flavorful	"a delectable treat"; "a delectable meal"

Word	Meaning	Examples
delineation (noun)	describing something precisely; representing well	"delineation of fruits"; "a perfect delineation of beauty"
emend (verb)	correct, improve, repair, alter	"emend the sales ad"; "emend the price"
hustle (noun)	busy activity and movement; commotion	"he showed hustle"; "hustle along now"
incombustible (adjective)	fireproof; made of material that does not burn	"incombustible safe"; "incombustible floor"
leverage (verb)	use to the maximum advantage	"leverage the resources"; "leverage the customers' needs"

Word	Meaning	Examples
levy (verb)	impose a tax or fee; to fine	"a levy on consumables"; "levy on sugary drinks"
maneuver (verb)	to move skillfully or carefully	"maneuver around the shelves"; "maneuver the cart"
mantle (noun)	a role or responsibility that is passed to another person, usually an honor	"passing the manger's mantle"; "accepting my father's mantle"
odorous (adjective)	giving off a smell, often foul smelling	"an odorous area around the meat department"; "an odorous cheese"
peon (noun)	a low ranking worker; someone doing menial work	"just a lowly peon"; "the peon is the one who cleans"
